Methodology:

- 1. Responses to the Risk Assessments are scored.
- 2. Risk Assessment Scores are mapped to a Risk Level per Table 1.
- 3. Provider contracts indicate the days worked per week. Table 2 shows for each number of contracted days worked per week, how many of those days will be remote. The remaining days will be on site. Table 2 is read as follows:
 - a. Find in Column 1 ("Contracted Days Per Week") the number of days you are expected to work in a week
 - b. Read across to the column with your Risk Level. The intersection of your Contracted Days Per Week and Risk Level is how many days in that week you can expect to be working remotely. The remaining days you will be scheduled to be physically present and on site.
